## 2 HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Signal Word: DANGER

Hazard Category: Acute Toxicity-Oral Hazard Category 3

6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Methods and Materials for containment & cleaning up:

Stop spill at source.
